STORAGE

Disconnect from electrical outlet. BE SURE DIRECT SUNLIGHT DOES NOT STRIKE MAGNIFYING SIDE OF MIRROR WHEN LEFT UNATTENDED. Allow to cool to room temperature before storing. Place in cool, dry area out of reach of children, where mirror will not be damaged. Handle cord carefully for longer life; do not jerk or strain at plug connections, or wrap cord around mirror for storage. This could cause damage to the cord or a short circuit. To store mirror, coil cord loosely.

MAINTENANCE

Your lighted mirror is designed for household

use and is virtually maintenance-free. No lubrication is needed. If cleaning becomes necessary, disconnect the appliance from the power source and wipe exterior with a damp cloth. Clean mirror surfaces with a glass cleaner. Do not light until you are certain mirror is completely dry. If any abnormal condition occurs, unplug the lighted mirror, allow it to cool, and return it to an authorized service center for repair.

- 11. Do not use on a soft surface such as a bed, where openings may be blocked.
- 12. Turn switch to **0** position and unplug cord before replacing light bulbs.
- 13. Do not place or store this furnishing where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- 14. If this furnishing falls into water, unplug it immediately. Do not reach into the water.
- 15. Never use while sleeping.
- 16. Do not use bulb greater than 20 watts. Use in any 120 volt, 60 hertz AC electrical outlet (ordinary house current). Do not use it in any other electrical outlet.
- 17. To protect against electrical hazards, do not use while bathing or in the shower.
- 18. Unplug the mirror from outlet before cleaning. Do not leave mirror unattended when it is plugged in.
- Never operate this furnishing with the air openings blocked. Keep the air openings free of lint, hair and the like.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of electric shock, this mirror has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug.

If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician to install the proper outlet. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not change the plug in any way.

CAUTION: BE SURE DIRECT SUNLIGHT DOES

NOT STRIKE MIRROR WHEN LEFT UNATTENDED; REFLECTED SUNLIGHT CAN CAUSE FIRE.

- Your circular lighted makeup mirror will swivel so that you can use either the standard view or the magnified view located on the opposite side.
- Plug cord into any standard 120 volt wall outlet. To turn on lights, simply turn the dial on the base to desired light setting.
- 3. After use, always turn switch to the **0** position.
- 4. The beauty and design of this mirror complements any decor. Therefore, you may wish to leave the mirror displayed. However, if you choose to store the mirror, see STORAGE section for detailed information.

SPECIAL FEATURES

This lighted makeup mirror uses incandescent light bulbs with special coating, simulating lighting in three different settings: home, office and day.

TO REPLACE BULB

CAUTION: TURN OFF POWER AND UNPLUG.
ALLOW TO COOL AT LEAST 3 MINUTES BEFORE
REPLACING BULB.

NOTE: Do not use a bulb greater than 20 watts. Contact the Conair service center at 1-855-926-6247 for replacement bulb information (ask for replacement #RP3435B).

- Remove the two screws located on each side of the mirror. (Fig. 1)
- Carefully lift 0 the top half of the housing from the bottom half that is affixed to the stand.
- 3. Unscrew the old bulb and replace with the new bulb. (Fig. 2))
- 4. Carefully replace the top housing half after locating and aligning the screw holes to the bottom half. If the holes don't line up, turn top half of mirror 180°.
- 5. Insert two screws into screw holes and tighten.

TO PREVENT ELECTRIC SHOCK, MATCH WIDE BLADE OF PLUG TO WIDE SLOT, FULLY INSERT.

CAUTION:

RISK OF FIRE, USE ONLY 20 WATTS MAXIMUM 120 VOLT; TYPE T BULBS.
