

2. If you decide you want a closer trim, adjust the 5-position comb attachment to a shorter setting and go over your beard until you achieve the desired length

#### **UNDER THE BELT**


At first, your shave might not be as close as you expect. However, this is normal. It takes time for your skin and hair to adjust to the new procedure and for you to learn how to effectively use the

Most blade users will push too hard and therefore not get a satisfactory shave. You must press

gently so the hair can get into the holes of the foil; pressing too hard makes the hair flat. Please be patient; use your body groomer 10 to 12 times before you judge its performance.

#### BLENDING THE JAWLINE


Attach a jawline comb to the trimmer, hold the trimmer in an upright position and begin trimming under your jawline, using short, even strokes.



## TRIMMING YOUR MUSTACHE

1. Start with a clean, slightly damp mustache (NOT WET).

2. Comb through your mustache in the direction
