HOW TO CHANGE CURLING WANDS

- 1. IMPORTANT! The element of the appliance will become very hot when plugged in and switched on. Before fixing or removing any attachments, ensure the appliance is cool, switched off and is unplugged.
- 2. Turn locking dial to the right to unlock. 3. Pull attachment straight off the handle.
- 4. Push other attachment into power handle. Barrel insulator should securely connect into locking dial on power handle.
- 5. Turn locking dial to the left to secure attachment in place.

WARNING: This unit will get very hot within a few seconds and should not be placed in contact with the scalp, face, ears or neck during use.

WARNING: When the High setting is chosen, the curling wand will have an extremely hot barrel. Always do a test curl before using the curling wand to ensure the proper setting for your hair type.

IMPORTANT

A heat-protective glove has been supplied to help protect your fingers from temporary contact with the barrel when wrapping the hair around the appliance.

Please note that the heat-protective glove is only designed to give initial contact protection. Discomfort will be caused by prolonged contact with the hot surface.

A bonus, heat-resistant storage pouch has been supplied. After using curling wand, unplug and store in pouch.

Never leave your curling wand on and unattended. However, should you fail to turn the wand off, it will shut itself off automatically within 60 minutes.

USER MAINTENANCE

Your curling wand is virtually maintenance free. No lubrication is needed. Keep all vents and openings clear of dirt and dust. If cleaning becomes necessary, disconnect the unit from the power source, allow to cool and wipe exterior with a cloth. If any abnormal condition occurs, unplug the unit, allow it to cool, and return it for repair to an authorized service representative only. No repairs should be attempted by the consumer.

CAUTION


NEVER allow the power supply cord to be pulled, twisted, or severely bent. Never wrap the cord tightly around the appliance. Damage will occur at the high flex point of entry into the appliance, causing it to rupture and short circuit. Inspect the cord frequently for damage. Stop use immediately if damage is visible or if unit stops or operates intermittently.

STORAGE

When not in use, your appliance is easy to store. Allow appliance to cool, then simply store out of reach of children in a safe, dry location. Do not ierk or strain cord at plug connections. Do not wrap the line cord around the appliance. Allow the cord to hang or lie loose and straight at the point of entry into the appliance.

To turn on the unit, simply press the I/O button. The blue LED will blink. Once the default temperature has been reached, it turns solid.

To select your temperature, press the I/O button again. Press and release button until you reach the temperature you desire. As the temperature increases to the next setting. the LED lights will blink as follows:

Temperature setting is set to 293°F (145°C)

The blue LED light blinks, then turns solid when the temperature has been reached

Temperature setting is set to 320°F (160°C)

The blue and green LED lights blink, then both turn solid when the temperature has been reached

Temperature setting is set to 347°F (175°C)

The blue, green and vellow LED lights blink, then all turn solid when the temperature has been reached

Temperature setting is set to 374°F (190°C)

The blue, green, yellow and orange LED lights blink, then all turn solid when the temperature has been reached

Temperature setting is set to 400°F (205°C)

The blue, green, yellow, orange and red LED lights blink, then all turn solid when the temperature has been reached

To turn off the unit, press and hold the I/O button for 1-2 seconds, and the curling iron will power off. All LED lights will turn off.
