TROUBLESHOOTING

If your rechargeable trimmer does not seem to be taking a charge, take the following troubleshooting steps before returning it for repair:

1. Be sure the electrical outlet is working by plug-

ging in another appliance to test the outlet.

- 2. Make sure the electrical plug is not connected to a switch which turns power off when lights are turned off.
- 3. Be sure you have inserted the trimmer properly into the charging stand, that all connections are secure, and that the trimmer switch is in the "OFF" position.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Before using your trimmer for the first time, place the unit in the charging stand and charge it for 16 hours. Always place the trimmer in the base with the ON/OFF switch in the OFF position.
- 2. Always check to see if the charging light is on when you place the trimmer in the charging stand. The switch must face forward for the trimmer to slide properly into the base and fixed
- 3. Plug the adaptor into any wall outlet (at the voltage listed on the label affixed to the adaptor). Unplug adaptor when not in use.
- 4. The adaptor may become warm while charging. This is normal.

Preserving the batteries:

In order to maintain the optimum capacity of the rechargeable batteries, the unit should be recharged for 16 hours every 3 months approximately.


USER MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

CHARGING THE TRIMMER

1. Remove the trimmer and all accessories from the cradle and turn the cradle upside down. Turn over the safety flap, insert the plug into the hole provided by pressing firmly and close the flap. Slide the cord into the groove provided. Put the cradle back upright and plug in the adapter (Fig. 1)

2. Place the turned off trimmer in the charging cradle and check that the charging light is on.

- 3. Once fully charged, the trimmer can be used for 30 minutes
- 4. Before using the trimmer for the first time, allow it to charge for 16 hours.
- 5. The subsequent charging times should be 8 hours.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE NI-MH BATTERIES OF THIS UNIT

To obtain and maintain the longest battery life possible, allow it to charge for 16 hours approximately every three months. Moreover, full battery life of the unit will only be obtained after three complete recharge cycles.

ATTACHMENT AND REMOVAL OF ACCESSORIES

Make sure the unit is turned off before changing the trimmer heads and accessories. To attach a head, place the bottom of the accessory on the appliance and press the whole head in until it clicks.

To remove a head, hold the handle in one hand and remove the head with the other by pushing it upwards (Fig. 2).

To remove the special cutting guide for the body, push one side of the guide upward.

WATER-WASHABLE HEADS

Remove the heads from the unit (as indicated above) before placing them under running water. Make sure that the used head is completely dry before using the appliance again.

USING THE CUTTING GUIDES

The cutting guide is very practical and guarantees a level cutting height.

IMPORTANT: Always put the cutting guide on BEFORE turning the trimmer on, and turn the trimmer off before removing it.

The cutting height of the trimmer is adjusted manually. To increase the cutting height, push the cutting guide upwards. To reduce it, push the guide down. The selected height is displayed on the back of the appliance.

MAINTENANCE OF BLADES AND ACCESSORIES

Remove the cutting guide after every use.

Regular maintenance of the trimmer blades will keep them in optimal working condition. To do this, brush the blades and accessories regularly with the cleaning brush.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of the blades will keep the trimmer in optimal working condition.






